

## Spectraloc™ Use and Care Instructions

All Spectraloc™ Outdoor fabrics are engineered for the rigorous demands of outdoor products. For easy day-to-day maintenance of your Spectraloc™ fabric follow the guide below:

- Blot liquid spills with a clean, dry cloth.
  For oil-based spills, apply an absorbent such as corn starch, then remove with a straight edge.
- 2. Spray on a mild cleaning solution of soap (such as Dawn or Woolite) and water.
- 3. Rinse the fabric thoroughly to remove all soap residue.
- 4. Air dry.

For persistent stains on your Spectraloc™ fabric, follow the detailed instructions below:

- 1. Brush off loose dirt.
- 2. Spray on a cleaning solution of water and mild soap.
- 3. Use a soft bristle brush to clean.
- 4. Allow cleaning solution to soak into the fabric.
- 5. Rinse thoroughly until all soap residue is removed.
- 6. Air dry.

Spectraloc<sup>™</sup> products should only be allowed to air dry.

Hand wash fabric or use soft bristle brushes. Avoid scrubbing, hard bristle brushes or any other abrasive cleaning method.

Protect the area around your Spectraloc™ fabric when using bleach or other chemical solvents that may discolor non-Spectraloc™ fabrics. Bleach can have harmful effects on the natural environment around you. Please follow all safety and environmental precautions according to the bleach label. Always rinse Spectraloc™ thoroughly with tepid water before allowing to air dry.

If wrinkling occurs, use an iron on the lowest heat setting. As iron temperatures may vary, first test a small inconspicuous area before ironing the entire piece. High heat can severely damage our synthetic fabric. DO NOT use a steamer or an iron set to the steam setting.
